

EUGENE P. BOYLAN

Eugene Boylan is currently the program director for the senior medical mental health service at Moses Taylor Hospital, Scranton, Pa. He manages the 22-bed inpatient gero-psychiatric program for Horizon Health Corporation, Lewisville, TX. Dr. Boylan received his Master of Science in education from Marywood College in Scranton, PA, and his Bachelor of Arts in psychology from East Stroudsburg State College East Stroudsburg, PA.

At the Moses Taylor Hospital, Mr. Boylan oversees the gero-psychiatric program and its contractual relationship, which has been extended for three three-year periods under his direction. His program has won awards for its clinical quality.

At Moses Taylor, Mr. Boylan is also responsible for the implementation and development of a sales/marketing program to promote referrals from community referral sources including psychiatrists, general practitioners, nursing homes, and assisted living programs. Through marketing efforts, his program has increased its average daily census from 14.1 to 15.7. He also supervises professional staff (nurses, social workers, and activity therapists); prepares yearly program budgets; and does program strategic planning and development.

Before holding his current position, Mr. Boylan was the clinical supervisor on the adult unit at First Hospital Valley, Wilkes-Barre, PA, where he supervised staff, assigned cases, carried a case load, oversaw discharge planning, and took part in quality-assurance projects.
