

## **Bruce Michael Sack, M.D.**

Bruce Michael Sack graduated summa cum laude from Oakland University with a Bachelor of Arts in biological science. He is also a graduate of Wayne State University School of Medicine, and he did his four-year, post-graduate residency in psychiatry at Sinai Hospital, Detroit, Michigan, where he served as chief resident of psychiatry. Dr. Sack is board-certified in psychiatry and neurology as a diplomat and is board-certified in geriatric psychiatry.

Dr. Sack has functioned as a psychiatric consultant to the Detroit Medical Center (formerly Harper-Grace Gerontology team), the Whittier Towers, Borman Hall, and Prentis Manor. He has been a lecturer in geriatric psychopathology at Sinai Hospital and Wayne State University. He is a member of the American Psychiatric Association and Michigan Psychiatric Society, where he served on the Committee on Aging. He is also a member of the American Medical Association, the Michigan Psychiatric Society, and Oakland County Medical Society. In 2002, Dr. Sack was a psychiatric consultant for McKesson HBOC, where he assisted in developing InterQual's geropsychiatry admission criteria.

Dr. Sack has been the medical director of the geropsychiatry unit at Botsford General Hospital, Farmington Hills, Michigan, since it opened in December 1987. He was instrumental in the development of the clinical program.
