Attached are copies of five forms developed by the Medical Staff of Brentwood Behavioral Healthcare of Mississippi, which is a subsidiary of Psychiatric Solutions, Inc. The first is an Informed Consent Form that includes language addressing recent guidelines on monitoring of patients receiving second generation antipsychotics (SGA's) and language addressing the recent FDA black box warning for suicidality monitoring of patients taking antidepressant medication (see #4 and #6 on the form).

The second page of the handout is a Medication Guide approved by the FDA, which the FDA recommends be given to caregivers of children and teenagers when an antidepressant medication prescription is filled. The bottom of the form has space for a signature of the caregiver to acknowledge the receipt of the form, with a "yellow-backed" carbon copy to go on the patient's chart. The caregiver for every child and adolescent patient treated with an antidepressant at Brentwood receives a copy of this form.

The third form titled "Monitoring for Patients on SGA's" is a form that each patient taking an SGA receives at the time of discharge from Brentwood, in order to encourage the patient to obtain the follow up monitoring described on the form. This form also has a "yellow-backed" carbon attached so that the patient's signature acknowledging receipt of the form can be included in the chart. A copy of the form is also sent to the patient's outpatient healthcare provider.

The fourth form is a Physician's Discharge Order sheet that contains a box to check to indicate the assessment of the patient's risk for harm to self or others at the time of discharge. This is not intended to be a prediction of future risk, but does provide evidence that an assessment was done of the patient's suicidal and homicidal risk at the time of discharge.

The last form included in this handout is a Physician's Progress Note, which contains check boxes and other prompts to assist physicians in documenting their work on daily rounds, including interval history, mental status exam, assessment, and plan. This form also contains a prompt for the assessment of risk for harm to self or others while in the hospital.
